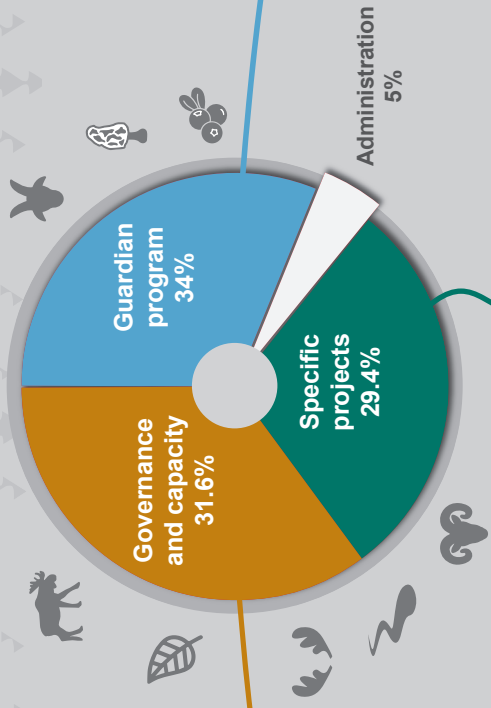

GOVERNANCE AND CAPACITY

- Incorporating Indigenous knowledge, laws and practices into shared decision making
- Incorporating Indigenous impact assessment criteria and review for shared decisions on environmental assessment and permitting
- Building 3 Nations Society governance structure and capacity
- Implementing consent-based decision-making pilot projects for wildlife management
- Developing standards for collecting and sharing wildlife harvest information to inform shared decision making using all local, Indigenous, and scientific knowledge
- Developing trusted and shared information sharing agreements
